Walter Rodney's How Europe Underdeveloped Africa (1972)

This term we will carefully study Walter Rodney's classic and great work on Europe's oppressive relationship to Africa, *How Europe Underdeveloped Africa*.

In this work Rodney (1942–1980) looks at the question of what "development" is, at the history of Africa's development prior to the European intrusions into Africa in the fifteenth century, at African contributions to European capitalist development, and at how Europe has set about systematically underdeveloping Africa.

Rodney's study is a fundamental one concerning African history and remains essential reading for scholars and social activists today.

We will read and discuss the entire work during the Spring term.

The Spring term will run for 14 weeks on Friday evenings from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM starting on Friday, February 14, 2025 and continuing until Friday, May 16, 2025.
